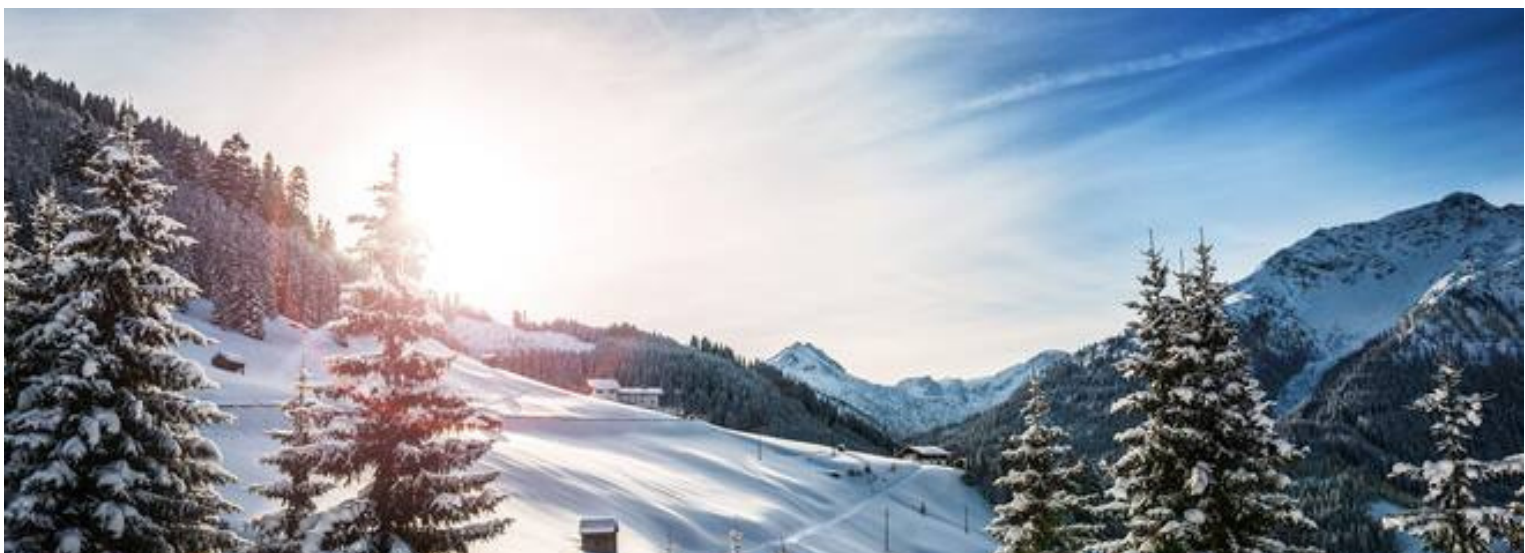
Different Skiing Levels

WHATS AROUND?



Salzburg - Being Mozart's birthplace, this town hold international reputation and still today Mozart's spirit seems to guide through the streets and lanes. Apart from the Residence, the House of Nature and the Castle Hellbrunn, Salzburg cathedral is without doubt the main attraction in the Old Town. 94KM



Salzwelten Hallien - Salt of Mount Dürrnberg is what gave the city its name. Prince Archbishop Wolf Dietrich von Raitenau guides you through the worlds of salt and tells you about the "White Gold" which was mined 2500years ago by the ancient Celts. The salt was Prince Archbishop's means to make Salzburg one of the most beautiful cities in the world.



Kitzbühel - Every winter Kitzbühel becomes a mecca for many ski enthusiasts. Guests from all over the World come to see the well-known Hahnenekamm Race, one of the most famous of all the downhill races. This picturesque interesting mixture of Tyrolean tradition and the flair of a cosmopolitan city is well worth a visit. 20KM



Rattenberg - With only a population of 440. this medieval spot is the smallest town in Austria. It was first documented in 1254. Being one of the few cities with a well-preserved settled down near the glazier's workshop in Kramsach which h a 300years glassblowing tradition. Today the town is centre of the Tyrolean glass blowers. 25KM



Swarovski Kristallwelten Watten's -Visit the Swarovski Crystal Worlds, created by the famous Austrian artist André Heller. They hold a mysterious world full of wonders and fantastical gems. Enter the Crystal World through the mouth of a giant and be surrounded by an incomparable Experian of sounds, scents and lights. 56KM



Innsbruck - The busy capital of Tyrol is characterized by the impressive scenery of the mountain chain Karwendel. The picturesque Old Town holds, apart from many other sights, the medieval "Golden Roof", the Court Palace where you will see the "Black Men" bronze statue. There are also a wind rage of museums to visit. 85KM
